## **NOTES**

Membership of the Chamber shall be open to every company which is directly interested in the mining or processing of minerals or in the exploration for minerals, to every individual who is engaged in mining for his own account and to individuals and to Companies and Organisations or individuals who have a common interest with employers in the mining industry.

Membership of the Chamber shall be in eight classes viz:

### **(i) CLASS A**

Companies which either:-

- (a) Control or administer other companies engaged in the mining industry; or
- (b) Mine without being controlled or administered by any other Class A member, and which are determined as being large companies by the formula fixed in terms of Clause 11; and shall include
- (c) The Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe

### **(ii) CLASS B**

Companies which either:

- (a) Control or administer other companies engaged in the mining industry; or
- (b) Mine without being controlled or administered by any other Class A or B member, and which are determined as being medium-sized companies as determined by the formula fixed in terms of Clause 11.

### **(iii) CLASS C**

Companies which by virtue of their own operations or those of companies controlled or administered by them are determined as being small companies by the formula fixed in terms of Clause 11.

### **(iv) CLASS D**

- (a) Smallworker companies.
- (b) Exploration companies not directly associated with any Member in Classes A to C
- (c) Civil engineering, or shaft sinking contractors.

### **(v) CLASS E**

Companies that are Providers of Goods and Services to the Mining Industry and who are not directly associated with any Member in Classes A to D.

**(vi) CLASS F**

Associations of Smallworkers, Mine Managers, Geologists, Mining Engineers, Surveyors and District Mining Associations and other Associations related to the Mining Industry.

**(vii) CLASS G**

Any individuals whether they be engaged in mining for their own account or not, and any Company or Association associated with the Mining Industry and does not fall within the classes of membership of A - F.

**(vii) CLASS H**

- (a) Honorary Members.
- (b) Honorary Life Members.

**FORMULA**

The Formula presently used for classification of group and company members and for the calculation of subscriptions in Classes A to D is:

$$\frac{\text{Value of Production}}{1\ 000\ 000} + \frac{\text{Employees}}{250} = \text{Points}$$
